Kat Smith stated that just as a heads up as to the reason why these were approved in advance is because we had talked previously about moving the money into cd's for a better interest rates and in order for Randy to do that, the meeting minutes had to be approved.

Treasurer's Report:

1. March Financials-

For income, we had some interest of \$48.45, legal settlement money of \$1,025.35, builder permit fees of \$8,250.00, property owner permit fees of \$500.00, and \$2,750 in violation fines totaling \$12,573.80 in total income. For expenses, we had \$193.85 in health insurance, \$27.40 in gas, \$108.36 for office supplies, rent for \$300, website/technology for \$200, payroll for \$2,919.04, professional fees for tax preparation of \$300 legal fees for \$481.25 and taxes for \$2290.00 giving a total of expenses of \$6,914.79 and leaving us with a Net Income for March with \$5,659.01.

Aaron Sanford made a motion to approve the March financials as presented. Eddy Plummer seconded the motion. A vote was taken, and the motion passed unanimously.
