Touring violation report for January showing a total of 42 letters delivered to residents:

- Total for the month was 42
- 35 violations resolved (some resolutions may be from violations issued in previous months)
- 12 hours toured during the month for a total of 125 miles.

#### NEW BUSINESS

1. Discussion and possible action on Purple Heart designation.

Mac Simpson stated that I have been involved a little bit with the Purple Heart Designation. I have been in contact with the Bastrop Area President and asked them what it would take for us to become a Purple Heart Designated Community. Basically, you would need a Proclamation to be made and the Purple Heart signs. I think posting one on the Lovers Lane entrance, Kaanapali area and one off of Tahitian. It will be less than \$200 for 4 signs. I believe the County are the ones who install these.

Ruth Bullock stated there was red tape to go through as you just cannot put the signs up. The ones on the Hwy, the city, TX dot and the committee were all involved.

Mac Simpson stated I am sure we will have to get some sort of approval since it is a county road.

Greg Stigall stated I believe you have to go through the County Commissioner.

Ruth Bullock stated TX dot owns the street no matter where they are.

Michele Plummer stated we did the Neighborhood Watch signs and we just went through the POA. We also made a Facebook post, and we got volunteers to help put them up.

Mac Simpson stated he will reach out to Mel Hamner.

The standard size of the Purple Heart sign is 18x24 and they are \$38 each.

Mac Simpson made a motion to adjourn. Charles Brown seconded the motion. A vote was taken, and the motion passed unanimously.
