- Checks will be issued:
 - college/university scholarship: June 18th or the July 16th POA meeting.
 - trade/vocational: June 3rd or the July 1st ACC meeting.
- The decision of the scholarship committee is final and cannot be reviewed or challenged.

Scholarship Criteria/Checklist:

- (1) Completed application (typed or neatly printed)
- (2) Recommendation letter from school counselor, teacher, coach or employer
- (3) Proof of enrollment from the college, university, trade or vocational school the student will be attending
- (4) Unofficial H.S. transcript <u>including the most recent semester completed</u> or a G.E.D.
- (5) Resumé (which includes extracurricular participation and volunteer experiences)
- (6) Complete a 500 word essay from the following prompt: Explain how your chosen career or field of study could potentially impact Tahitian Village or any other community in which you may live.
